We discussed the success of the "Drive Thru Communion" and the decision was made to begin this Sunday.

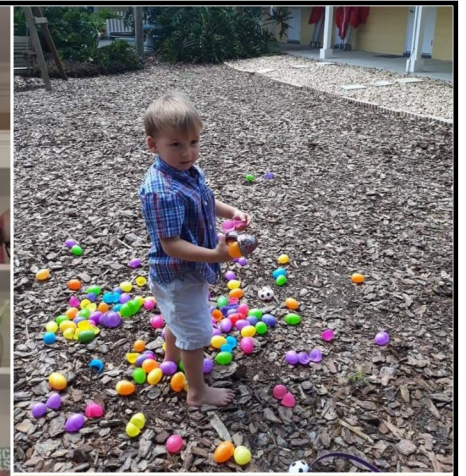
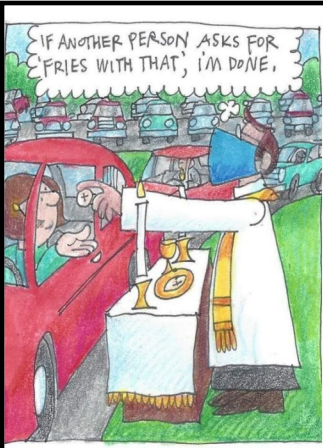
The Clergy and staff finally, sorta, have worked out our "new normal" but we are all looking forward to seeing and worshipping again with every one face to face.

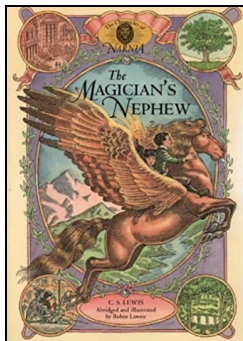

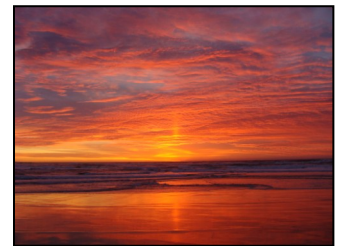

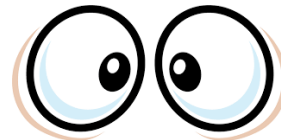
