

### **Our Diocese**

The Church in Honduras is in dire need. Most clergy are paid from the diocesan budget whose payroll for the bishop, staff and mission clergy is about \$35,000 per month. All reserves are now gone. The Church is dependent on income from their schools, which are all now closed and thus generating no income. Many of the clergy are bivocational and cannot work because businesses are closed. Many clergy and clergy families are in desperate need for financial assistance.

Honduras' Bishop Lloyd has requested assistance from the Presiding Bishop, the National Church program budget and Bishop Brewer and the Diocese of Central Florida. Food is rarely available. When it is available it is very expensive. With the schools closed, children are hungry. Businesses and schools are closed. Bishop Lloyd warns that without significant aid- people will die. Please help raise funds for relief for our companion Diocese of 35 years!
