The Altar Guild is a volunteer group of the parish whose ministry is to care for the altar, vestments, vessels, and altar linens of the parish. Liturgy begins and ends with the work of the Altar Guild because Altar Guild members prepare the sanctuary for services, and clean up afterwards. The contribution of each Altar Guild member is important.
