Members undertake a Rule of Life, incorporating the Rule of Prayer and the Rule of Service. A Daughter pledges herself to a life-long program of prayer, service and evangelism, dedicated to the spread of Christ's Kingdom and the strengthening of the spiritual life of her parish.

* A Christian order is a community of men or women living under a religious rule. Because Daughters of the King accept a [Rule of Life](#), we define ourselves as an order, not an organization. Our community is found primarily in our local chapters, but it extends around the world.

We don't just enroll as members and attend meetings. After a three-month period of study and discernment, each new member takes vows to uphold the two Rules of the Order, the [Rule of Prayer](#) and the [Rule of Service](#).

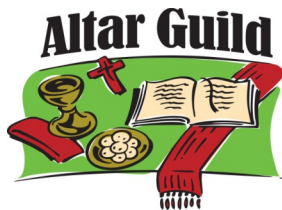

Altar Guild

The Altar Guild is a volunteer group of the parish whose ministry is to care for the altar, vestments, vessels, and altar linens of the parish. Liturgy begins and ends with the work of the Altar Guild because Altar Guild members prepare the sanctuary for services, and clean up afterwards. The contribution of each Altar Guild member is important.

Here at St. Stephen's we have a unique situation because we have two very different Worship areas with very different needs. For the early service we usually set up and prepare for Sunday Worship on Saturday morning but because of the special needs of the later service worship area, set up is done at 10:30 Sunday morning. It is ideal to have two altar guild members serving on a team that works one Sunday a month. We have not been able to do that in a while. We really need more folks to help with this ministry.
