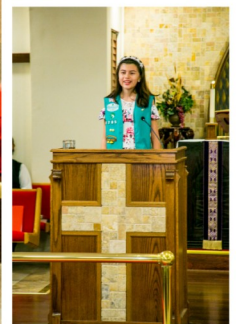

Copies of the Bibles Summaries are in each worship Area.


