Today is called both "Palm Sunday" and "Passion Sunday."The first name comes from the fact that it commemorates Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, when the crowd had palm branches (Mark 1:1-11). The palms today are blessed so that they can be carried in the procession and they should then be taken home where they will serve as a reminder of the victory of Christ which was celebrated in today's procession. The second name comes from the fact that the narrative of the Passion is read on this Sunday (it otherwise wouldn't be read on a Sunday, since the next Sunday is about the Resurrection).


