# **Restrictions Are Tightened in Our Diocese**

We got word from the Diocesan Office late last week that we would be tightening restrictions in the wake of higher CoVID-19 infection percentages in our area.

Many of the restrictions remain the same, but a few have changed.

- We continue to require face masks at all functions.
- We continue to remain socially distanced as we worship
- We continue to urge hand-washing and we provide hand sanitizer in our worship areas.
- We continue to use contact tracing in order to be able to notify worshipers of any CoVID-19 exposures.
- We continue to provide single-use children's worship packets to be taken home following worship
- We continue to pass the peace distantly
- We continue to have no large choral groups leading music. Singers must remain masked.
- We continue to omit the passing of the collection plate. It will remain in a single location for your convenience or you may wish to mail your pledge or give online.

- All small group meetings are limited to 10 people in one place at a time.
- No food or drinks are to be served. (No coffee hours, dinners or receptions)
- All outside groups meeting in our facility will observe these same diocesan mandates.
