UPDATE FROM POLK ECUMENICAL ACTION COUNCIL FOR EMPOWERMENT

The PEACE Network's persistent lobbying for affordable housing is paying off in Lakeland.

First, the Lakeland City Commission agreed in April to allocate \$75 million in next year's budget for affordable housing after some of its commissioners participated in the PEACE Nehemiah Action this spring.

At which St. Stephens Episcopal was among the churches with members proudly participating. Your prayers, your conversations and your actions helped make that happen.

Then, on July 13, Lakeland city commissioners dedicated \$1 million more for affordable housing. That additional batch of funding comes from the American Rescue Plan Act. Cities have until the end of December 2026 to spend the federal money.



"This is a very exciting development for our city and happened because of the hard work our PEACE network has put into this issue over the past year," PEACE House Steering Committee members said.

They also shared this exchange:

Newly-elected Commissioner Mike Musick asked the question, "Why is affordable housing such a big priority for our city?"

Mayor Bill Mutz and Commissioners Stephanie Madden, Sara Roberts McCarley and Phillip Walker all stood up to explain why it is important to them that this housing is developed and prioritized.

We want to celebrate our officials for doing that and let them know PEACE is supportive and behind them every step of the way.

PEACE hasn't had similar results in Winter Haven yet, but we're awaiting the August presentation of their city commission's strategic plan.


