#### **Nehemiah Action Almost Here**

Polk Ecumenical Action Council for Empowerment holds its biggest event March 29 at Silver Moon Drive In, 4100 New Tampa Highway, Lakeland. Registration and prayer begin at 7 p.m. You're



in the comfort and safety of your vehicles.

We're urging as many St. Stephen's members as possible to attend and support PEACE at this Nehemiah Action. This year, we're asking:

Local law enforcement (city and county) to adopt an adult citation program as an alternative to arrest for some adults accused of non-violent misdemeanors.

Lakeland, Mulberry and Winter Haven city officials to work with PEACE in developing programs to reduce the serious health danger of mold in local housing.

The adult citation program is like one PEACE persuaded many in law enforcement to adopt for children who commit minor offenses. Those cited still face penalties or obligations but are spared the job-threatening stigma of an arrest on record.


Many of these arrests now are for traffic issues like expired tags and unpaid fines. We're in the first phase of this drive. A press conference and prayer session are scheduled 6 p.m. March 15 at Fort Blount Park, 345 W. Davidson St. in Bartow.


#### **March Food Box Collection**
