The Coed Cursillo weekend is scheduled for September 22-24, 2023 at the Canterbury retreat center.

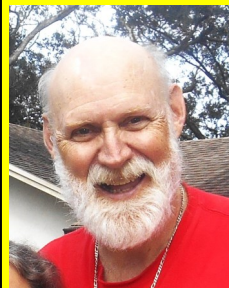

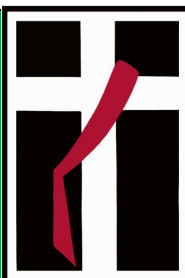

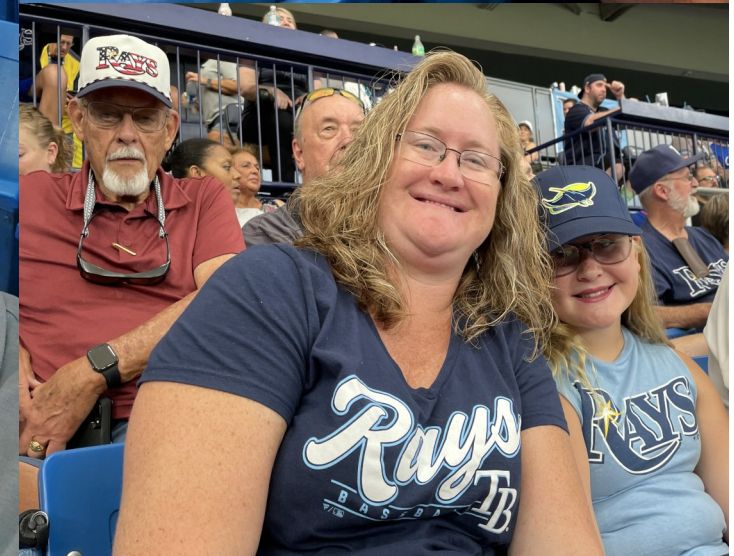
