There will be one service, outside in the Garden Chapel, at 10:00am Palm Sunday. The service begins with a blessing and procession of the palms and will include the reading of the Passion Gospel, recounting the Crucifixion. Stay after and learn how to make Palm Crosses.

Join us at 5:00pm for a homecooked Passover Dinner of roast lamb or beef. Then we'll share the Exodus Story through the symbolic Seder plate. Fundamental to both Judaism and Christianity, we'll hear and taste how the LORD hears the prayers of His people, frees us from sin and death, and brings us to a Promised Land, just as Jesus shared with His disciples at the Last Supper.

As Holy Week begins, the Lenten Quiet Service offers a brief hour to be still before the Lord and consider what He has done for us. From “mandatum,” the Latin word for Commandment, we remember that at the Last Supper Jesus gives His disciples and each of us a New Commandment: to love one another as He loves us. With that first Communion at 7:00pm and the stripping of the altar, this powerful evening demonstrates humble service and the loneliness in the Garden on the night Christ was betrayed. “Watch and Pray.”



The liturgy for Good Friday will be held at Noon and 7:00pm in the Sanctuary. We Adore You, O Christ, and We Bless You. Because by Your Holy Cross, You Have Redeemed the World.
