#### P.E.A.C.E.

About 1,000 people, including members of St. Stephen's, were at Monday night's 25th annual Nehemiah Action by Polk Ecumenical Action Council for Empowerment. But our work isn't done. A PEACE team has a meeting scheduled Tuesday April 8 with the Polk County administrator. PEACE members will gather outside the administration building, 330 W. Church St. in Bartow, at 9 AM that day for a prayer gathering in support. Our purpose is to get Polk County to develop a plan to help keep 1,000 lowincome Polk seniors in their homes. It would provide help with basic needs such as making nutritious meals and housekeeping.

We got cooperation Monday from Winter Haven's police chief and assistant city manager on another PEACE goal of training and encouraging officers to use diversion alternatives instead of arrests for adults who commit minor offenses. Diversion imposes consequences without an arrest record.






**Pictorial Directory**
