Episcopal Traditions

We would like to bring back several of the church's traditions at St. Stephen's.

The Offertory is the part of the service where the congregation's offerings of money, bread, and wine are presented to God. It is both a symbolic and practical moment within the Eucharist.

- **<u>Presentation of Gifts</u>**: The bread and wine, along with monetary offerings, are brought forward to the altar.
- <u>Offertory Sentences</u>: The priest may recite one or more sentences from Scripture that invite generosity or thanksgiving.
- Offertory Hymn or Music: Often, a hymn or instrumental music is played during this time.
- **<u>Preparation of the Table</u>**: The priest and altar servers prepare the table (the altar) for the Eucharist, arranging the bread and wine.
