Once we see how many people are interested, we will move forward with the order. Thank you!



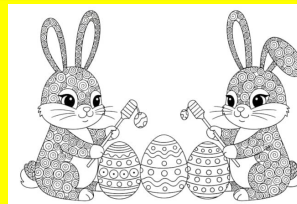
## Stations of the Cross
